HOPE Children's Choir (HCC): Open enrollment for grades K–8th. Join us for a special "Kid building adventure known as "The BEE-Attitudes" and sing songs that teach children how to BEE-lieve, BEE-friend and BEE-Christlike! Regular class starts January 20th.

Elementary HONOR CHOIR is open to all 2nd to 5th grade students. Enrollment in this class allows participation in the regular HOPE Children's Choir *AND* the Elementary HONOR CHOIR. Class fee includes choral music for spring semester. Special rehearsal; January 6th (9:00-11:00am). Regular class begins January 20th. This group will be performing twice during the spring semester: Chorister's Guild Festival (Saturday, March 17, 2012) and HOPE Spring Program (Friday, April 27, 2012)

Acting Class (grades 1st – 6th) open to all students with a maximum class size of 8 students. No audition is required. Emphasis will be on learning the basics of drama, theater and acting; focusing on stage directions, vocal projection, diction/articulation, body language, confidence, and memorization. No previous drama experience is necessary, but students who have done other dramatic activities/productions are welcome to join the class to continue to grow in their acting experience. This class has a parent presentation on April 20th and does not participate in the HOPE Fall program. (Acting class is taught by Miss Heather Hill)

SPOTS: (Short People Of The Shepherd) A music exploration class for ages 3 – 6 years that includes: instruments, rhythms, music games, old Sunday school songs, folk songs etc. Parents are encouraged – but not required to participate. Regular class starts on January 20th and follows the HOPE Music schedule for 11 weeks. Last class is April 13th.

R.O.B.O.T.S. (Really Outstanding Boys Of The Shepherd) This is a Reader's Theater group for boys in grades 6th-12th. (Returning members do NOT need to re-audition). Auditions are January 20th, the first day of class. Bring a poem or speech to read for audition.

"Joyful Noise Makers" Handchimes: This performing class will review musicianship skills and practice new techniques with the handchimes. They will perform at the ACSI Handbell Festival and the HOPE Spring Concert. This class is open to all previous Dickens members. (All others who are interested in participating – please contact Mrs. Harned). Special rehearsal meets on January 6th & 13th (1:30-2:50pm). Regular class begins January 20th.

Beginning/Intermediate Handchimes: Did your child enjoy watching the Dickens Handchime Choir? Does your child want to learn to play handchimes? Are you interested in auditioning for next years Dickens Handchime Choir? This is a class to learn and/or review basic handchime techniques. Open to new students and all Dickens students through 5th grade. This class has a parent presentation on April 20th and does not participate in HOPE Spring program. Regular class begins January 20th with a maximum enrollment of 12 students. (Taught by Miss Kealani Jensen)

Sound of HOPE: This class is open to all boys and girls in grades 6th and up. Special rehearsals are on January 6th & 13th (9:00–11:00am) Regular class begins January 20th. Fee includes choral music for spring semester.

- The ACSI Festival is Tuesday, April 17, 2012 (for 6th to 8th grades HOPE students ONLY)
